- Complete on-site training.

Essential Functions:

- Provides crisis intervention support for each patient in an atmosphere of warmth and compassion through listening and other helping skills.
- Presents all options through accurate information on abortion, parenting and adoption.
- Follows all policies and procedures.
- Provide support to father's according to the MENtoring policies and guidelines.
- Keep current on referrals and outside agencies PRC partners.
- Complete charting after each consultation.
- Attend volunteer staff meetings.
- Utilize time wisely at PRC.
- Be a support to both Head Coach and Client services director.
